### Fence 1 – OLYMPIC CELEBRATION

Another RIO 2016 Look of the Games department contribution, celebrating the RIO 2016 Olympic spirit.



### Fence 2 – PEDRA DA GAVEA

The RIO 2016 Look of the Games department created very interesting ways to show the Rio de Janeiro natural beauties, represent here by the Pedra da Gavea, another post card of Rio de Janeiro.





### Fence 3 – BASIC NATURAL

A free design, design in a traditional showjumping way, but with a special shape and movement on it. There is no specific theme, and it was designed so that the horses can have a break of so many different and special jumps.



### Fence 4 – CAPIM DOURADO

Traditional craftwork originally from the region of Jalapao, in the state of Tocantins, on the north region of Brazil. The material used is the straw of the *Syngonanthus nitens* type of grass, very coveted for its golden color.





### Fence 5 A, B, C – FLORES TROPICAIS

The Heliconia is a typical tropical flower than can be found in many different states of Brazil and its colours are remarkably bright and happy.



### Fence 6 – BALAO DE FESTA JUNINA

It is one of the most important parks of Rio, a Research Centre. The Jardim Botânico do Rio de Janeiro is represented here by its Portal and one of its Fountain.
